Easy Guide to Storage Removal



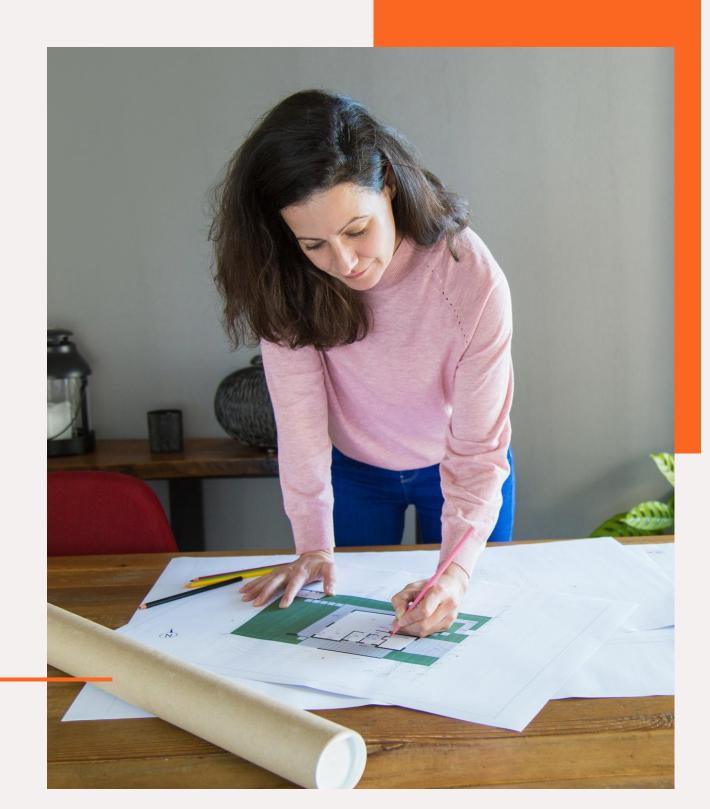
Step 1: Assess Your Storage Space



- Visit your storage unit or area
- Identify the volume and type of items
- Note fragile, bulky, or unused items

Step 2: Create a Removal Plan

- Set a removal date or deadline
- Make a checklist of tasks
- Arrange transport or a removal service
- Inform your storage provider if needed





Step 3: Sort and Categorize Items

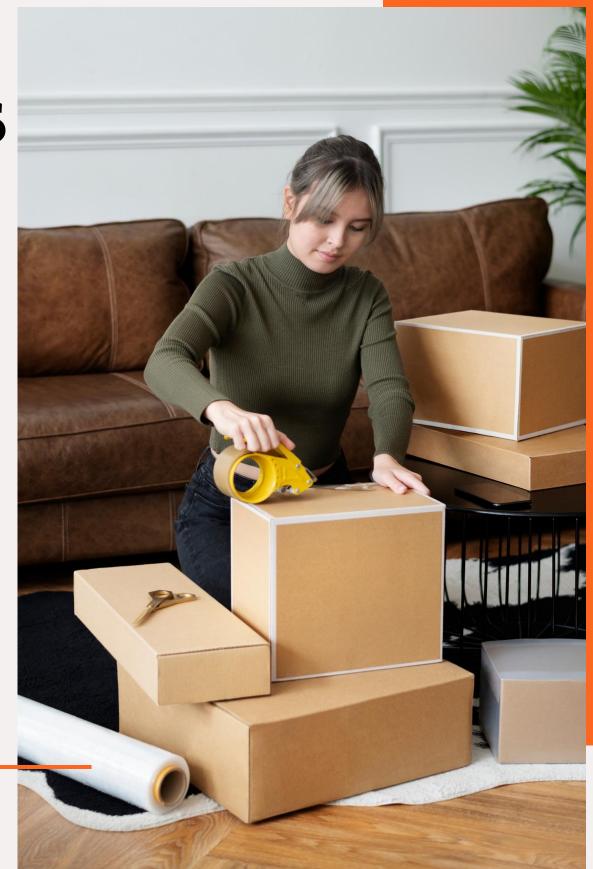


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- Group items into: Keep, Donate,
 Sell, Discard
- Set aside essentials or valuables
- Declutter to reduce moving volume

Step 4: Gather Packing Supplies

- Get sturdy boxes, packing tape, labels
- Use bubble wrap or blankets for fragile items
- Color-code or number boxes for easy tracking





Step 5: Pack Efficiently

- Pack similar items together
- Label all sides of each box with content and destination
- Keep heavy items at the bottom, light on top
- Pack a "first-open" essentials box

Step 6: Arrange for Transportation

- Hire a trusted removal service
- Confirm timing, cost, and service scope
- Ensure access to storage unit on removal day
